

3 Villages Constructed in Malawi

With support from our donors from around the world, we managed to construct 187 homes in Malawi which provided 3 villages to poor families.

The vision was to develop three existing villages building approx. Over 60 new houses in each with a community hub to include a masjid to provide a community space for social, spiritual, and community services. This created a significant impact not only on the physical environment of the village but also on the health and well-being of all the beneficiaries.

The villages have provided the community to access the community facilities, education, learning and women development programmes, as well as access to clean water through the provision of a new borehole. The houses comprise of two rooms, fully bricked walls, well ventilated metal windows sheet metal roofs.

Masjid Complex: 3 Masjids Built

In the three villages we have built 3 Masjids which create a community hub for the spiritual, social and community development of the residents. Currently most of the villages do not have a masjid and have to travel many miles or if they have one it is often in very poor state of repair. The masjid will include wudhu facilities and toilets and provision for women.

Water Sanitation: Borehole Constructed

A borehole has been built to provide fresh water to the villages whereas before families would have to walk miles to gain a bucket of water, through generous donations this difficulty has become an ease and families can have access of water without any challenges.
