

## **LIVE UPDATES – Jordan August 2021**

Aid delivery in Jordan - August 2021 Jordan hosts around 658,000 registered Syrian refugees, although the real total of Syrians is estimated at around 1.3 million when those not registered are taken into account.

An overwhelming majority of the total Syrian refugee population (estimated 81%) are living out of camps. With this in mind, the CEO of Benefit Mankind Hafiz Dr Abdussamad Mulla travelled to oversee and monitor projects that donors donated since 2020 as part of our project management evaluation program. Hafiz Dr Mulla states: "It was a pleasure to travel to Jordan to witness the great work being carried out, I got to see all our shelter homes donated over the last 18 months, the families we have supported with our empowerment programs and at the same time all the key medical projects.

I would personally like to thank our donors and partners for making this possible and we aim to continue supporting thousands of refugees as often as possible InshaAllah." Urgent need at this moment are the shelter homes which cost £2,200 as families are still living in makeshift tents and the weather conditions are extremely hot and in the winter it is extremely cold.
